Nonprofit Addressing the HIV/AIDS Crisis with Children in Africa

This organization and charity nurtures the mental, physical, and emotional growth of Ugandan HIV/AIDS infected orphans by providing healthcare, education, food, clothing, and shelter. They promote the values of an enabling, physical, and psychological environment that fosters growth and self-actualization in order for the children to assume leadership roles and have a positive impact on Ugandan society. The organization seeks to ensure that the most vulnerable children in the developing world receive the same healthcare and education as children in the developed world. Responsibilities for interns with this organization stem from a desire to help with fundraising, capacity building, and advocacy. Typical duties include promoting events, organizing details for fundraisers, and coordinating marketing materials. Hardworking individuals may earn the opportunity to identify projects of interest within the organization to spearhead.

Marketing and Promotions for a Health Organization

This organization is a charity dedicated to reducing the incidence of osteoporosis and promoting bone health. They provide information to the public and health professionals on all aspects of the disease and offer support to people with osteoporosis, their families, and everyone at risk for the disease. Interns in the marketing department will assist in promotion of the organization and its charitable events. The position may also involve event planning and management as well.

Marketing Intern for International Children's Charity

Since 1982, this multinational NGO and charity has mobilized a force of medical professionals and volunteers to make it possible to provide safe, effective reconstructive surgery for children born with facial deformities such as cleft lip and cleft palate. They have provided free surgeries to over 200,000 children in more than 50 countries, healing their smiles and bringing hope for a better future.

Psychology/Social Sciences Internship at a Dublin Women's Center

This organization was founded with the aim of helping Irish women access family planning information and services. Its current range of services provides broader-based primary healthcare services to both women and men and advocates for an influences public policy and awareness by speaking out on women's health issues. Sample tasks may include but are not limited to help edit/add to website content, manage social media accounts, assist agency administration in service delivery, visit various clinics and assist in giving presentations/workshops to disadvantaged populations in Dublin.
