Solar Citizens - Communications Intern

Solar Citizens is an independent, community-based organization bringing together millions of solar owners and supporters to grow and protect solar in Australia. We advocate for the rights of more than 5 million solar owners and the millions more who wish to go solar. Together, we take action to protect the rights of millions of Australians with solar to cut bills, create clean power and take energy generation back into our own hands. We support a vision of an Australia where a major portion of our electricity is generated from the sun, where the rights of solar owners are protected and where all Australians are able to install solar on their homes. The intern will develop and produce video content, participate in staff discussions and planning, and help manage supporter in-bound email.

Affinity Intercultural Foundation - Marketing and Event Management Intern

Affinity Intercultural Foundation's mission is to create and sustain enduring relationships with people through intercultural and interfaith dialogue. They do this by incorporating core principles of sincerity, service, consultation, integrity, interdependence, positive action and balance into events such as public lectures, annual Ramadan dinners, and other cultural events that bring together different groups of society. The intern will provide assistance on lecture programs, dinner events and the like by helping promote the event online using social media. Tracking registrations and assisting with the setup on the day of the event such as greeting attendees, supporting the AIF team to deliver a smooth program. It would be desired if they are tech-savvy specifically with uploading videos/posts on social media platforms, assisting with websites.

Cancer Council - Human Resources Intern

Cancer Council is the only Australian organization that works across every area of every cancer: conducting and funding world-class research that underpins our work across the cancer journey preventing cancer, supporting people as they navigate the cancer journey, advocating to ensure that governments take action on cancer. We are there not only for those touched by cancer today, but to prevent and manage cancer for future generations. Interns may assist with a variety of clerical and administrative services to support the Volunteering & Partnerships Coordinator, research, update, roll out of new policies and procedures, participating in the implementation of HR (for volunteering) initiatives, support the delivery of training and development workshops, and review of position descriptions.

The School is located on the Kensington campus and incorporates the UNSW Optometry Clinic, which is open to the public and provides a wide range of clinical services. It also incorporates the Optics and Radiometry Laboratory, which provides a test, calibration, research and development service in matters related to light and colour. The Rupert Myers Building is also home to several other eye research and education organisations including the Brien Holden Vision Institute, the Centre for Eye Health, Optometry Giving Sight and the Vision Cooperative Research Centre, a transnational research centre devoted to addressing the issues of visual defects and preventable blindness. Interns will analyze data, prepare a written report on the data, attend seminars, and participate in skill surveys and information meetings.
